Copyright Instructions for Authors

- 1. **Submission Agreement**: By submitting a manuscript to Journal of Toxicology and Regulatory Policy, authors agree to abide by the following copyright instructions.
- 2. **Copyright Ownership**: Authors retain the copyright to their work and grant Journal of Toxicology and Regulatory Policy the right to publish the article under a Creative Commons Attribution (CC BY) license. This license allows others to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the work, even commercially, if they credit the author(s) for the original creation.
- 3. **Author Responsibilities**: Authors affirm that the submitted manuscript is original, has not been previously published, and is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Authors are responsible for obtaining any necessary permissions for copyrighted materials included in their manuscript and for disclosing any potential conflicts of interest.
- 4. **Permissions for Reuse**: Authors grant readers the right to reproduce, distribute, and display the published article for non-commercial purposes, provided the original author(s) and source are credited appropriately. Commercial use of the content requires permission from the copyright holder.
- 5. **Post-Print Archiving**: Authors are encouraged to self-archive a pre-print or post-print version of their manuscript in institutional repositories, pre-print servers, or personal websites, provided it includes a citation to the published article in Journal of Toxicology and Regulatory Policy.
